

## Please Bring the Following to Your Fuel Assistance Appointment:

State or federally issued photo ID
Proof of citizenship or qualified alien status, examples include: social security card or
birth certificate, permanent resident card, etc.
Verification of all sources of income for the 30 days prior to the appointment.
Countable income includes but is not limited to the following:
<ul> <li>□ Wages including seasonal/per diem/on-call employment</li> <li>□ Unemployment</li> <li>□ Child support/alimony</li> <li>□ Interest/dividends</li> <li>□ Pension/annuity</li> <li>□ Odd jobs income</li> <li>□ TAFDC/EAEDC &amp; SSA/SSI/SSP/SSDI/RSDI</li> <li>□ Veteran's benefits</li> <li>□ Capital gains, lump sums such as lottery/gambling, miscellaneous income</li> <li>□ Zero Income Form for all household members 18 and over, if no income</li> <li>□ Self-employment (your most recent 1040 tax return &amp; all attachments /schedules)</li> </ul>
Mortgage, homeowner's insurance, and property tax bills if you own your home
Copy of lease (and verification of rental subsidy, if applicable) if you rent
Documentation of current financial aid awards showing all grants, loans,
scholarships, and work study income for college students
Dates of birth for all household members
Heating vendor, account number, and name of account holder
Current electric bill showing name of account holder, service address, and account
number

This information is required for all household members regardless of age. You may be asked for further information during the interview depending on your circumstances.
